## DIRECTORS NOTE



In the fall of 2013, Walt Disney Studios released a movie that wasn't quite like any other movie the company had released before. Yes, this was a princess movie, which is what you would typically expect from a Disney production. Yes, it was a love story, another expectation of a new Disney film. And yes, it was full of magic and music, obviously a Disney staple. So what makes Frozen different than the rest?

When Frozen was first released I was a freshman in high school, and, like a lot of freshman girls, I was very concerned with one thing. Boys. I remember going to the theater to see Frozen with my parents and, to this day, I still remember the feelings that it brought up in me. As the film progressed, I found myself relating to Anna. A girl who was searching for her Prince Charming, just like me. But by the end of the movie I had learned something. You can find true love in a man, sure, but that's not the only place it can be found. Anna found her true love through her sister, and as the youngest of three girls in my family, that was something I had never even considered before. Love my sisters!?! I mean of course I loved them, but I never fully appreciated them or understood their love for me until I saw Frozen.

I know what you are thinking, "Lucy watching a movie is not the reason you love your sisters... that's crazy." And to that I would say, "Yes, you're right." BUT, as I was riding home from the theater, all I could think about was them. There is quite an age gap between my sisters and I, so by this point in my life they had both been out of the house for awhile, and sometimes it felt like I was an only child because of it. But when I saw the way Anna and Elsa saved each other, I started to realize I didn't relate to Anna in the way that I had thought I would. I now saw her as the little sister, making mistakes but always coming back to her sister. When I think of Elsa, I see my own sisters, looking out for me, allowing me to make mistakes, and loving me unconditionally. My sisters have always had my back, even when I didn't want them too, or thought I knew better, and Frozen opened my eyes to that fact. It made me love them more. And that's why, to me, the message I took away from Frozen is so different than any other Disney film before its time. Frozen makes you realize that romantic love can be fleeting, but a family's love is forever. There was no Prince Charming that swooped in to save the day, just two sisters who had each other, and that was enough. I'd like to dedicate my work in this show to my sisters, Megan and Chelsea, because whether everything goes wrong, or everything goes right, I know they will be proud of me no matter what.

As you watch KFAD's production of Frozen today, I hope that you too think of your sisters, brothers, mothers, fathers, cousins, all family members, because this is a family love story, and that love is strong enough to melt even the most frozen heart.



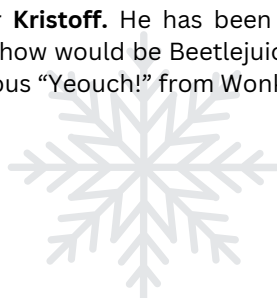
